

# SIM card installation

Removable Backed Phones (Old Android)



- 1 Turn your mobile phone off**
- 2 Remove the back cover of the mobile phone.**
- 3 Carefully remove the battery.**

Please refer to your phone's instruction manual if further assistance is required.
- 4 Once the battery is removed, locate the SIM tray.**

If applicable, remove your old SIM card by carefully sliding it out with your finger.
- 5 Remove the new SIM from the packaging**

Select the compatible SIM bracket (Micro, Nano, or Standard). If you are unsure about which size to use, simply Google the model of the phone to confirm the size required.
- 6 How the SIM fits into the slot.**

Next, look for a small image located near the SIM slot which will indicate how the SIM fits into the slot.  
Please note: some mobile devices have a microSD card slot in the same location as the SIM card slot. Please ensure that you correctly locate the allocated SIM slot.  
*Some mobile phones have more than one SIM card slot. If you are only using one SIM card, please use the 'SIM 1' slot.*
- 7 Insert SIM card**

With the Aussie Broadband logo face up (gold chip is facing down), insert the SIM card.
- 8 Carefully re-insert the battery and back cover**

Be sure to put the battery in the correct way. Please refer to your phone's instruction manual if further assistance is required.
- 9 Turn your phone on and wait a few moments.**

If your SIM card is activated and inserted correctly, you should see 'AussieBB' appear as the phone's network.
